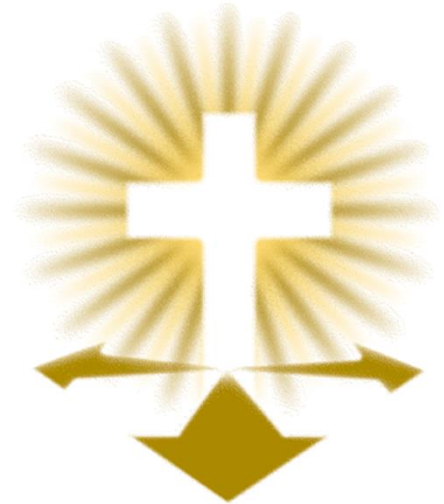
27 Pray for the church nationally to grow younger and attract more youth and young adults and for strategies towards this.
