

1 Give thanks that we are surrounded by a host of brothers and sisters who have gone before us. Give thanks that God is faithful to his promises. Pray for opportunities today to be a pointer to Jesus on your Frontline. Pray that the Spirit will continue His work of transforming each of us into his likeness. Pray by name for 3 people who don't know Jesus.

2 Pray for the second session of the Bible Course this evening, that people will begin to see the big picture. Pray that a love of, and hunger for, the Bible will grow in those on the course.

3 Give thanks for the work of Mike Ashworth, our treasurer, and also Ann-Marie Chittock and Paul Kirkup as they help. Pray that they know God's blessing. Pray too that God will provide for our financial needs. Give thanks for the generosity of so many in the church.

4 Pray for the TCPT tonight – for the work which they do on Thursdays and at the week-end. Pray that the seeds sown will produce a harvest. Pray too for the first meeting of the First Friday club, that people are encouraged in their faith.

5 Give thanks for those who lead worship and welcome people. Pray that HT will be a place where newcomers are welcomed and people build lasting and positive relationships.

**6 Pray for our services today, asking for a fresh encounter with the Spirit of Jesus. Pray for all the church meetings taking place on the HT site today, including the Nepalese Church and the African Church meeting in the Galpin Hall.**

7 Pray – and attend tonight's PPP – that it will expand the kingdom of God in Aldershot. Pray for a hunger for God and his presence.

8 Pray for the people of the USA today as they elect a new President. Pray for mercy and grace for whoever is elected. Pray for peace in the world, especially in Syria and throughout the Middle East.

9 Give thanks for all who serve on a Sunday – tech team, readers, prayers, coffee rota. Give thanks too for those who volunteer at other times – cleaning, flower arranging, etc. Pray that they will be blessed as they give of their time.

10 Pray for Tom Chittock on the Logos Hope. Pray that the ship will bring eternal hope to people. Pray too for Glen and Anita, Mohammad and Maryam and Moira in their various ministries in Rhyl, Liverpool and Birmingham.

11 Give thanks for Simon and for the growth of the children's work and for the weekly Kids Club. Pray for the meeting tonight. Pray for all the families we are in touch with through this work and the Contact team. Pray again for 3 people who don't know Jesus.

12 Pray for the government as they seek to find a way forward through Brexit, as well as all the other on-going challenges of running the country. Pray for wisdom, humility and grace for ministers and those in opposition. Ask God to remind us that our security lies in Him, not in the economy or the world.

**13 Give thanks for those who died in the cause of peace in two world wars and since. Pray for peace in our world today. Pray also for Jackie Maw as she preaches in HT today, that we will listen to what the Spirit says to us through her. Pray for wisdom for her in moving forward with the seed team and the work in Wellesley, especially during her treatment for cancer.**

14 Pray for all in our church family who return to work this morning at the start of a new week. Pray that they will be signposts to the love of Jesus to their colleagues, and will know when to say something, and what to say. Pray for three people who don't know Jesus.

15 Pray for high profile church leaders, Archbishop Justin, the Pope, Bishop Andrew. Pray for a special anointing of the Spirit for them, and for courage, wisdom and strength in the decisions they have to make and the example they set. Pray for protection for them.

16 Pray for Don as he oversees the building. Pray for the work on the North Porch, and the outcome of the quinquennial inspection. Give thanks for the results of the Gift Day and pray for wisdom as to how to move forward with the Crossover refurbishment.

17 Pray for Women's Hour and Contact today. Give thanks for the faithfulness of those who organise, and pray that God's kingdom will come as a result of what happens today. Pray God's blessing on the angels that have been knitted and will be being distributed in December.

18 Pray for the work of Tear Fund, as they seek to enable churches to help communities to help themselves. Give thanks for their focus on Jesus as the light of the world. Pray for wisdom in the way that they use the money they are given

19 Pray for refugees across Europe and in Turkey, Lebanon and Jordan, for the agencies that work to supply their needs. Pray for justice, peace and an end to fighting in this region, and for the light of the Gospel to shine brightly.

**20 Pray for all the services on our site today, for a freedom in worship, and an awareness of the presence of the Spirit. Pray for the churches we have links with in India, that the pastors will be encouraged and strengthened in their ministries.**

21 Pray for the PCC meeting tonight, for wisdom and the guidance of the Spirit in the discussions and decisions that are made. Give thanks and pray for the wardens and other PCC members.

22 Give thanks for all the Fellowship and POD groups as they meet weekly to encourage discipleship, fellowship and pastoral support. Pray for our on-going transformation into the likeness of Jesus Christ. Ask to see what area of your life needs particular attention.

23 Pray for Jonathan, John and Simon while George spends time in London. Pray for George as he spends time in London, for grace and peace. Pray too for Cara in her training, that she will both feel at home at HT, and develop spiritually and academically over this time.

24 Pray for the Pastoral Care team and the Parish Nurses. Give thanks for them and many others who give practical expression of God's love for us. Pray for John and Jacquie as they co-ordinate the work. Pray God's healing for those who are sick, and his comfort for those who are housebound.

25 Give thanks for the mental health drop in. Pray that we will see full healing for those who suffer from mental illnesses. Pray for the many in Aldershot who suffer from depression, and pray for the peace and prosperity of the town. Pray for three people who don't know Jesus.

26 Pray for the men's breakfast at Squires today – for Tim Cross as he speaks, and for those who hear. Pray for all who preach, that they will handle the word of God passionately and correctly. Pray for an anointing of the Spirit in their preaching, and that we as a church will be doers of the word and not just hearers.

**27 Give thanks that we can meet without fear of persecution. Pray that there is a real hunger for an encounter with the Lord Jesus Christ today. Pray too for those who persecute them.**

28 Pray for the ACT prayer meeting this evening. Continue to pray for the prosperity of Aldershot, for a positive spirit in and over the town. Give thanks for the reduction in the suicide rate in the town and continue to pray against people taking their own life. Pray again for three people who don't know Jesus.

29 Pray that the Lord will strengthen and enrich all marriages at HT. Give thanks for our families, and pray that our Christian family will be a place where we learn love, grace and forgiveness.

30 Pray for the work of the Vine and the Source as they minister to vulnerable people, especially at this time. Ask God's favour for their human and financial resources. Pray for Ellie leading the Source and Mags leading the Vine, for wisdom, discernment and courage for them in the decisions they have to take.

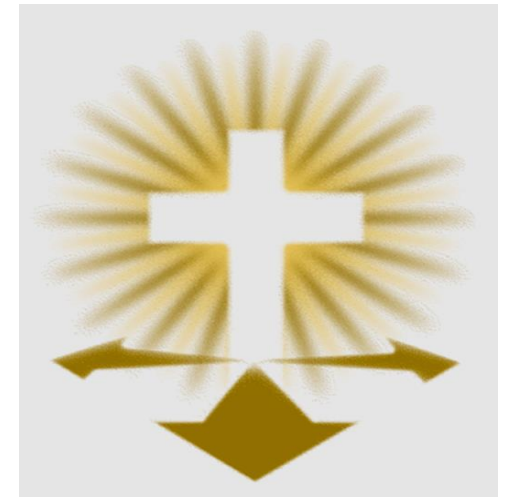
