

MOULDING CULTURE, 1st – 7th
Matthew 5:13-16

Jesus said, “You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty *again*...

“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden...

“Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

As we give thought to the Bible passage above

Firstly give thanks to God our Father that salt is being tasted and light is being seen in our community and beyond

Pray for the people at Holy Trinity; we are all appointed to shape and influence culture because of where we have been placed – to be salt, to be light.

Pray for Christians in all levels of government. Rushmoor Borough Council, in the UK Parliament and those who govern and rule in other nations.

Pray for the Christian run charities in Aldershot, or others you may support, that they will be places where many people flourish.

Pray for the Wellesley church plant, as it seeks to connect with people moving in to the urban extension. Bless and declare an open door for the good news of Jesus.

MOUTHPIECE FOR TRUTH & JUSTICE, 8th – 14th
2 Samuel 12:1-13

Then the LORD sent Nathan to David. And he came to him and said, “There were two men in one city, the one rich and the other poor...

“The rich man had a great many flocks and herds.

“But the poor man had nothing except one little ewe lamb which he bought and nourished.

“Now a traveller came to the rich man, and he was unwilling to take from his own flock or his own herd, rather he took the poor man’s ewe lamb and prepared it for the man who had come to him.”

As we give thought to the Bible passage above

Firstly give thanks and glorify our Father that in every generation He has inspired His people to seek the welfare and fight for justice for the many that are despised and rejected.

Pray that Christians in our town will be prepared and ready to speak up for things that are true, just and good.

Pray that Christians will have courage for where it may be needed and wisdom to apply what is required.

Pray for all those whom we support who are seeking justice for persecuted Christians in the world, CSW, Open Doors and Barnabas Fund.

Pray for Christians who serve faithfully in the criminal justice system, that grace and mercy and truth and righteousness will prevail.

MESSENGER OF THE GOSPEL, 15th – 21st
1 Peter 3:15-16

“But sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always *being* ready to make a defence to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence; and keep a good conscience, so that in the things in which you are slandered, those who revile your good behaviour in Christ will be put to shame”

As we give thought to the Bible passage above

Firstly give thanks for the hope that we have within us, because of His amazing grace, mercy and love.

Pray that all Christians at Holy Trinity will be ready to give a reason for the hope that is in us. Pray to be alert to His timing.

Pray for specific opportunities to share the good news of Jesus, what He has done in your life, with those you come into contact with, family, friends, work colleagues, in our social networks.

Pray for a ‘wide open door’ for the message of Jesus in Aldershot.

Pray for the supernatural working of the Holy Spirit in Aldershot.

Pray specifically for one person on your frontline

THE JOURNEY ON, 22nd – 31st
Matthew 28:16-20

But the eleven disciples proceeded to Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had designated. When they saw Him, they worshiped *Him*; but some were doubtful. And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

As we give thought to the Bible passage above

Firstly give thanks that Jesus has 'all the authority', and that we are all called and appointed to co-labour with Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

Pray for all the teaching we have received over the weeks, that all at Holy Trinity will be encouraged and emboldened to share Jesus, in His timing, in the many different ways we have come to understand.

Pray that confidence will grow in us, that new and bold steps of faith in sharing the good news of Jesus will be taken by all at Holy Trinity. Pray for an increase of Holy Spirit expectation working in us and through us

Pray that Evangelists will be being birthed following the Frontline teaching.

Pray that Christians in our nation will be set ablaze with a passion for Jesus, to share Him, to minister for Him in every context.


