Read

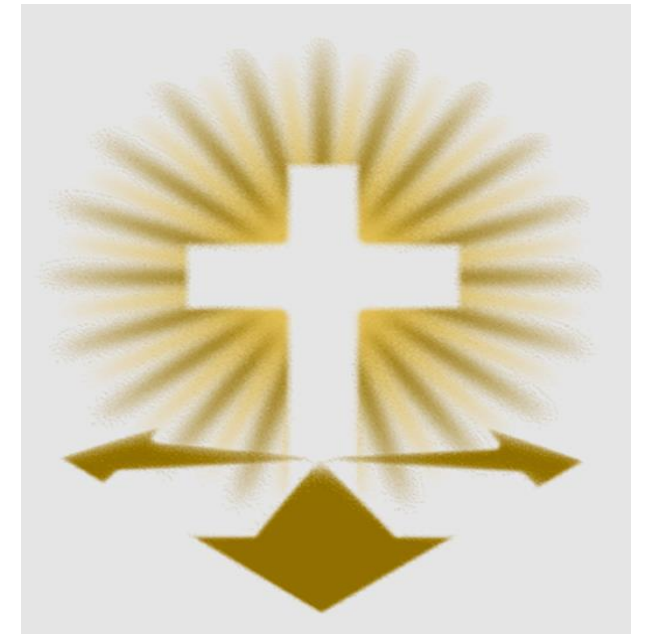
