

1. Pray for the Alpha and Start enquirer's courses which start tonight. Pray that relationships will be built and people will be open to hear the word of God. Pray for three people you know who are not followers of Jesus Christ.

2. Pray for an unblocking of the situation regarding the St John Hall; pray for favour with the council and that the way will be open for HT to acquire the hall. Pray too for Dave Haley and the group looking at the refurbishment of Crossover – for wisdom and creativity in their thinking.

3. Pray for renewing through the Holy Spirit for all key staff in their various roles of leading Holy Trinity for George, Jonathan, Simon, Debs, Cara and John. Pray for Cara as she combines training at St Mellitus with ministering here. Pray for Jonathan on sabbatical, that this will be a time of refreshment for him.

4. Pray for peace in the Middle East; cry to the God of peace for a cessation of violence and evil. Pray for the refugees from Syria in countries around, for the agencies that work to supply their needs. Pray for this broken region that peace and justice will be built.

5. Today pray for the preaching of the Word to be powerful and effective. Pray for all those who preach and those training to preach, that they will have a growing hunger for the Bible and desire to study. Pray too for a spirit of generosity in our Gift Day response.

6. Pray for a praying church as we gather for the PPP. Pray that the wiles of the evil one will be frustrated and many will come to pray. Pray too for those who are housebound and unable to join the church when it gathers.

7. Pray for one another that we would be equipped and feel confident to be a witness in the work place, amongst our family and friends. Pray for three people you know who are not followers of Jesus Christ.

8. Pray for those who clean the church, do the gardens, arrange the flowers, polish the brass, look after the buildings and help in so many unseen ways.

9. Pray for Simon in his role at HT as Children's Minister and for the growth of the children's work and for the weekly Kids Club. Pray for all the families we are in touch with and the Contact team. Pray too for those who have seen the advert for the Children and Families Minister, and are considering applying.

10. Pray for the response of the churches in Aldershot to the 'Who Cares?' initiative. Pray for clear leading by the Spirit, as people pray about what we could do to show God's love to Aldershot. Pray that we will remember that with God nothing is impossible.

11. Pray for the pastors in India we support along with their churches, families and ministries. Pray especially for Pastor Rao coordinating our support to them. Ask in faith for the moving of the Holy Spirit and the making known of the gospel in this nation

12. As we remember those who died in the two world wars and since, pray for peace in our world. Pray too for those who suffer because of the violence and cruelty of humans. Pray that those who work for peace in the world will enjoy God's blessing.

13. Pray for our Treasurer Mike and Paul and Annmarie helping with running the finances. Give thanks for the response to the Gift Day, and pray

that we will be able to make a start soon on the Crossover refurbishment.

14. Pray for all Fellowship groups and Women's Hour as they meet weekly to encourage discipleship, fellowship and pastoral support; pray for all leaders. Pray for three people you know who are not followers of Jesus Christ.

15. Continue to pray for those on the Alpha and Start courses, that people will be able to attend, and that people will be drawn to Jesus. Pray too for the Mission Shaped Introduction course – that those on the course will be excited by how we could create community.

16. Give thanks for what has happened so far with the Releasing Spiritual Gifts course, and pray for the meeting tonight – that there will be an openness to the Spirit, and a filling of all present. Pray that the whole church will be built up as the Spirit transforms us into the likeness of Christ.

17. Pray for the members of Rushmoor Borough Council – that the decisions they make will be taken for the good of the whole borough. Pray too for those who work in the emergency services, for all they do to serve the community.

18. Pray for the Families at HT meeting which will take place on Sunday 19th at 10am. Pray for Debs and Cara as they meet to chat with people about how and when to develop our work with families. Pray that people will sense if this is something that they are being called to.

19. We ask today that our worship will glorify God, that we will meet with the Lord of the world and the church, and that we will be filled again with His Spirit to be pointers to Him and His grace and love in the week to come.

20. Pray for the PCC as it meets tonight, for the decisions that will be taken. Continue to pray for George in his role as the Area Dean, especially as there are 5 churches in vacancy at the moment, which require his time and input.

21. Pray for the ongoing work of the Town Centre Pastoral Team, both in the days on Thursdays and on Friday and Saturday nights. Pray for more labourers in the harvest fields and thank God for a number who have responded and come to faith through this ministry.

22. Pray for the school assembly team as it meets to start preparing the Christmas assemblies to take into the schools. Pray for creativity and inspiration, and that the message of God with us will come across in a fresh and compelling way to the staff and children.

23. Pray for the communion service at Kingsley Court this morning. Pray for those members of HT who live at Kingsley Court that they will be salt and light there. Pray for all of us on our Frontlines – that we will point people to Jesus. Pray again for 3 people you know who are not followers of Jesus Christ.

24. Pray for God's rich blessing over all those who lead and are involved in the ministry of praise and worship at HT, give thanks for all musicians and singers in this vital ministry. Pray too for those on the tech

desk, and those who read and lead intercessions.

25. Pray for Pat and those who attend the Mental Health Drop in. Pray also for the Soul Sisters Upcycling event. Pray that both meetings will be a time of encouragement and joy.

26. Pray for a spirit of expectancy as we gather today, that the Spirit will be welcome as we gather, and that we will be open to his leading. Give thanks for the Prayer Ministry team, and pray that people will be blessed through their ministry today.

27. Pray for the ACT prayer time tonight – pray for the unity of the whole church in Aldershot. Pray for the work of the Vine and the Source as they minister to vulnerable people. Pray for those at HT who are involved with these two bodies. Ask God's favour for their human and financial resources.

28. Pray for our brothers and sisters throughout the world who suffer for their faith. Pray that God will sustain them in their time of trouble, and that they will remain steadfast in their faith. Pray for those who persecute them, that they will see the love and grace of Jesus Christ in those they persecute.

29. As we approach winter, pray for those who are homeless in Aldershot. Pray that there will be no suicides in Aldershot. Pray too that the Spirit will be poured out on all in Aldershot to bring healing for those who struggle with poor mental health and dementia and their carers.

30. Pray for Jackie Maw and the continued development of the Wellspring plant. Pray that as relationships are built with those who move into Wellesley, there will be a desire for a way to mark community on Wellesley and that the Wellspring will be a part of enabling this to happen.

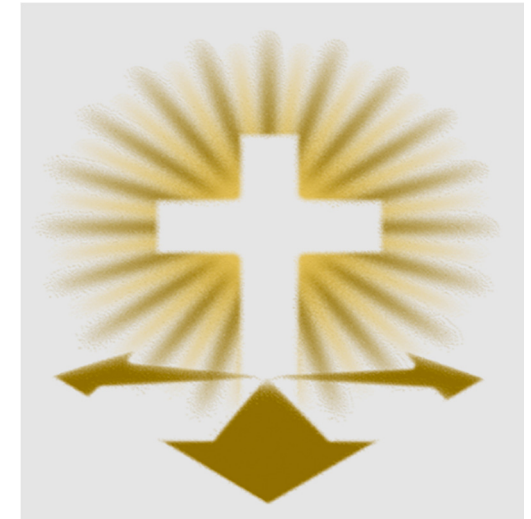
