

1. Pray for the Alpha course meeting this evening at George's house. Pray that relationships continue to build, that Jesus is more clearly seen and that hearts are open to his love. Pray for George and Jane as they fly home. Pray too for Cara as she flies to Rwanda for the start of her placement.

2. Pray for the First Friday Club which meets this evening, that the conversations will help to equip people to be ambassadors for Christ. Pray too for the Men's week-end at the end of April – that more will sign up and for the choice of theme and speaker.

3. Continue to pray for Jackie Maw and the team in Wellspring. Pray for the sessions that are being organised on Mindfulness. Pray for encouragement for them, as they sow into the new development on Wellesley, and that they will see kingdom growth.

4. Pray for all the services today, and especially for the Children's Service at 10am in the Galpin Hall. Pray for Caroline and Debs as they lead this and that many will come. Pray for an expectancy that we will meet with the Spirit of the living God, and that our worship will glorify him.

5. Give thanks for the opportunity to come together to pray at the PPP tonight, and that God has answered prayers from previous PPPs. Pray that as we come together to pray we hear the leading of the Spirit, and that God's will will be done here on earth as in heaven.

6. Pray for CSW, one of the missions we support, whose work was featured on Sunday 4th. Pray for those who suffer for their faith, or for standing up for what is right, that they will know the

support and encouragement of the Spirit. And pray that we will know how we can support them.

7. Continue to pray for Cara in Rwanda – pray for protection for her, and that this trip will be part of her preparation and training for ministry. Give thanks for those who regularly attend the Wednesday 11.15 communion and pray for God's continued blessing on this service.

8. Pray for George as he attends General Synod, from today until Saturday. Pray for the leaders of the church, that they will be wise in giving a lead to the church and to our nation. Pray too for Contact and Women's Hour as they meet regularly on a Thursday. Give thanks for the blessing that there has been over the recent past, and pray for Daphne, Jean, Debs, Joan and Pat as they continue to lead these two activities.

9. Pray for Parent-Pod as it meets today – and for the response to the advert for the Children's and Family worker post. Continue to pray for Simon at Shottermill. Pray for those who are helping with the various aspects of the work with young people – Alan, Ben, Caroline, Julia, Janet, Pauline, Barbara, Cara and Debs.

10. Pray for Barry Oak in his role as the safeguarding officer in HT. Give thanks that HT has been a safe place so far, and pray that it will continue to be a place of healing and wholeness and where there is an encounter with God.

11. Pray for all the services today, the Nepalese and African as well our two services – pray for those preaching, that there will be a faithfulness to the word. Pray too for Re:Form and the Youth Alpha – for Ben and Pauline as they lead this

12. Pray for the Borough Council, that in their planning they will be open to the guidance of the Spirit, and that the decisions they make will be for the benefit of the town and its inhabitants. Pray particularly for their thinking on the St John Hall, that they will look favourably on working with us.

13. Pray for The Vine and the Source and for other bodies which work with those on the margins in Aldershot. For both of these bodies pray for funding; for the Source, pray for Ellie, the CEO, Jos the Chairman of the Trustees and for The Vine pray for Mary. Pray too for a breakthrough for people who have become stuck in a rut of purposelessness, that the hope of new life which is to be found in Jesus Christ will bring light into dark places.

14. Pray for the final meeting of the Wednesday Alpha group. Give thanks for the way that this has gone, for the openness and depth of discussion; and pray that all who have been on it will continue to grow up into Christ, and know the joy of walking as disciples with Him. Pray for the first of the SHAPE courses which starts this evening, that many will come and find this helpful in finding out more of who they are and where they fit.

15. Pray for the table top ministry of the TCPT in the town today and on market days. Pray for the development of this ministry and that those who stop and talk will meet with the Lord Jesus. Pray too for the Weekend evening teams as they continue to go out. Pray for more people to be ready to go out.

16. Continue to pray for Dave, Don and the team as they work on the Crossover redevelopment. Pray that all the papers which

need to be submitted today are in order, and that the review meeting at the Diocese on March 1st will be positive.

17. Pray for the Preachers Meeting today – give thanks for those who have this gift and pray that all who preach will be anointed both in their understanding of the Bible and in their ability to teach and apply it. Pray that we would all seek to meditate on Scripture.

18. Pray for the services at HT today. Pray that meeting and worshipping together will help us all to grow up into Christ, and that these times will help us to know how we fit in Christ's body, and the part we are being called to play.

19. Pray for Jonathan and Sue as they seek the Lord as to their future. Give thanks for their ministry among us and pray that they continue to know the Lord's peace and joy. Pray specifically for a new house for them.

grow up into Christ, and that we will be built up in love as each part does its work.

24. Pray for the Prayer Ministry team meeting this morning. Give thanks for this ministry and pray that they are equipped to minister in the power of the Spirit, Sunday by Sunday.

25. Pray for all who help 'behind the scenes' at our services today. Give thanks for their willingness to serve, and pray that they will be especially blessed. Pray that our meeting together will be a time of drawing close to God.

26. Continue to pray for Tom Chittock in Germany – for blessing now and also for guidance for the future, and the next step once his time on the riverboat is done.

27. Pray for George in his role as Area Dean, with a number of parishes without a vicar. Pray for Alwyn Periera as he begins his ministry at St Michaels. Pray for those in leadership across the local churches, that there is a working together in the Gospel, to enable the light of Christ to be seen in Aldershot.


