

1. Give thanks for 10 years of ministry of the TCPT. Pray for the teams going out this weekend, for protection and godly conversations. Pray too for more people to commit to this work, and for wisdom to know how to develop this ministry.

2. Continue to pray for Jonathan and Sue as they both look for a house and wait on the Lord for future ministry. Give thanks for those who have offered hospitality to them.

3. Pray for the services today, and as we continue the series on the early church in Acts 2, pray that we will learn what it means for us in 2018 to be devoted to the teaching, the fellowship, the breaking of bread and to prayer.

4. Pray for the PPP this evening; give thanks for the opportunity to come together to pray, and pray that we will know the fellowship and the leading of the Spirit.

5. Pray for those who suffer with mental health illness. Pray that the peace of God will indeed rule in troubled hearts and minds. Continue to pray that there will be no suicides in Aldershot in 2018. Give thanks how this prayer has been answered over the past few years.

6. Give thanks for the Bible, and for what God has given to us in it. Pray for the Bible Society as they seek to bring the Bible to those who don't have one. Continue to pray for the Bible Course and that those attending will grow in their love for and discipleship of the Lord Jesus.

7. Pray for the SHAPE course which starts this evening. Give thanks for the encouragement that the previous SHAPE courses have been to those who have done them. Pray for the desire to grow up in all things into Christ.

8. Give thanks for Alice and continue to pray for her as she continues to settle into life in Aldershot and with HT. Pray for her as she looks for somewhere to live. Pray for the kid's club this evening. Give thanks for all who help with the various aspects of the children's work.

9. Pray for Aldershot as it celebrates Victoria Day, and the witness of the ACT during the procession. Pray for the Borough Council as they make decisions, and pray that these decisions will be for the benefit and flourishing of the town.

10. Pray for our services today – pray especially for Janet and all who lead us as we worship in song, giving thanks for all that they bring and give. Pray that there will be an awareness of and response to the presence of God, Father, Son and Spirit.

11. Pray for Cara as she travels up to St Mellitus today – give thanks for her ministry here at HT, and pray for her ongoing formation and training for her future ministry. Pray for peace and wisdom as decisions about future ministry have to be made.

12. Pray for Barry Oak in his role as the safeguarding officer in HT, giving thanks for all that he has done. Give thanks that HT has been a safe place so far, and pray that it will be a place of healing, wholeness and encounter with God.

13. Pray for The Vine and the Source and for other bodies which work with those on the margins in Aldershot. For both of these bodies pray for funding; for the Source, pray for Ellie, the CEO, Jos the Chairman of the Trustees and for The Vine pray for Mary. Pray too for a breakthrough for people who have become stuck in a rut of purposelessness, that the hope of new life which is to be found in Jesus Christ will bring light into dark places.

14. Pray again 'your kingdom come'. Pray that we, the people of God, will learn to live lives that point to Jesus. Pray for 3 people you know who aren't yet a follower of Jesus Christ, that they will come to know his love for them.

15. Pray for Jackie Maw and the growth of the Wellspring. Give thanks for what has been, and pray that Jackie and the team will know the guidance and provision of the Lord, so that the Wellspring will be a source of life and light to many on Wellesley.

16. Continue to pray for Dave, Don and the team as they work on the Crossover redevelopment. Give thanks for their perseverance and pray for the work that still needs to be done to bring the plans to completion. Pray too for Don as he oversees the maintenance of the whole of the HT site.

17. Pray for all the services on our site this Sunday and for Bishop Andrew as he comes and preaches at the 9.30 and 11.15 services. Pray for wisdom and protection for him as he leads the church in this diocese.

18. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem – and for peace to come in the Middle East (and especially Syria). Cry out for an end to violence and for the light of the gospel to break out in this region of the world.


