

1 Pray for the work of Wellspring and for Jackie and team as they visit those moving in and look to foster community in different ways. Pray for the mission council meeting this evening. Also, this All Saints day, pray for those who are grieving and the breaking of the effects of any curses from Halloween.

2 Pray for Debs and Danny, taking a well-earned break from today. Keep praying for ongoing growth in Kids Club.

3 Pray for our prayer ministry team as they meet today, as well as in all the situations of prayer for other people and ministering God's love and power into lives, whether at church, on the streets or in people's homes.

4 Ask that the Lord draws near to us as we gather in His presence and under His Word today and pray that we will all choose to draw close to Him, despite what might hold us back. Keep praying for our youth, both those doing Youth Alpha and for the Re:Form youth group.

5 As we have seen many great things happen as we have gathered to thank and seek our Heavenly Father in prayer over the years, pray for tonight's PPP and that many will choose to come and that we will see the much longed-for breakthrough in corporate prayer and so more of His kingdom coming to our church and town. Even pray for fireworks in the heavenly realms!

6 Pray for the emotional health of us all in the body of Christ and pray that we will all 'in all things, grow up into Christ.'

7 Pray for our MP, Leo; for wisdom in all his dealings. Pray for our wardens, Alan and Phil and all who serve in lots of ways.

8 Give thanks for the growth of Women's Hour and pray for blessing as they start to meet again today. Pray that they will nurture many in the love of God and draw many to Jesus and pray for Daphne, Jean and team.

9 Pray for George in his role as chaplain to a Sheriff in London and for his involvement in three key events in the next four days. Pray for TCPT and its meeting this evening and the Kids Club fireworks night.

10 As we approach Remembrance Sunday, pray for those in the armed forces and for those still suffering trauma from past conflicts and the wider families affected and for chaplains, SASRA and other specialists.

11 This Remembrance Sunday pray for a blessing on our gatherings, as well as a special poignancy to our time of remembrance (10.50-11.05) and for all in Aldershot for whom this is a particularly meaningful day.

12 Pray for our staff team; for John as he starts to re-join us at HT, for Cara and for the right curacy for her as well as her studies and for Alice, Debs and George with Chris and Danny helping and our LLMs (Jean & Ursula) and PAs.

13 Pray for those on the Growing Leaders course and for those mentoring them and for this evening's meeting.

14 Pray for those churches nearby that don't have a vicar and for George and others working to find the right people for them. Pray also for Mohammad, Maryam, Immanuel and Elisa a month into their time in Turkey with new home and schools and pray especially for Mohammad as the vicar of Ankara in a very Islamic country.

15 Pray for the new SHAPE course starting this evening and that it will be of significant help, both to all who come on it and also to us seeing the bigger shape of HT and discerning how best to work for God's kingdom together. Pray also for Contact and for this to be a stepping stone to families coming to HT and to faith.

16 Give thanks for our Worship Team and pray for the meeting this evening and the worship at HT week by week as we gather. Pray for Mike as Treasurer and for Chas looking to take on the reins as from January.

17 Pray for a good turnout and good fun for the church work day today and for all the preparations towards the building work due to start in the relatively near future.

18 Seek the Lord for a rich blessing on our gatherings this morning and for the Nepalese and African congregations as well as for guidance as to what more unity might look like.

19 Pray for PCC tonight, for clear decision-making and concise enough debate holding

diversity within unity. Pray about how we might transition to become an eco-church.

20 Pray for those who serve the town and the areas of disadvantage and challenge, especially The Source (and Ellie as CEO and Jos as Chair of Trustees) and The Vine (with Mary on staff and Jules T volunteering) as well as the CAB with several HT volunteers, the Wellbeing Centre, Inclusion and Step-by-Step.

21 Pray no suicides in Aldershot. Pray there will be no marriage break-ups at HT in 2018 and also for no cancer amongst the HT family. Pray for this evening's EHS follow up and the one next Monday.

22 Pray for those who sponsor children through Compassion, that these will be really positive two-way links and that God will raise up community-changers. Pray also for those who live at Kingsley Court and the growth of the kingdom there and for the Communion service today.

23 Ask God's blessing and protection for the pastors and churches we support in India, especially in times of growing persecution and those currently recovering from extreme weather conditions and illness. Pray especially for those in the dangerous state of Orissa.

24 Pray for the nation of Pakistan, especially Christians facing so much discrimination, false accusation, slavery and persecution. Pray that our one-off love gift at the end of last year will have the effect of transforming

the families of Sadeeq and Amin. Pray too for the family of Anwer Shah in hiding from continued attacks.

25 As we pray for our services, pray also for growth in our relationships in the family of Christ, that HT might 'grow and build itself up in love as each part does its work.'

26 Pray vision and unity over the ministers of the different churches and John Cook facilitating ACT and pray for a good monthly time of prayer to do battle over the town.

27 Take a stand in the heavenly realms for God's kingdom to come, His church to be built up, His Word to take root and for His love to reign in our gatherings, and take a stand against the evil one and his schemes. Pray particularly for the development of the team to start the chaplaincy to the Health Centre.

28 Pray for growth amongst the families of HT and as we reach out to families. Keep praying for Alice and her teams. Dare to pray that we will see whole families being baptised soon.

29 Pray for Danny in his role in the diocese to equip churches to grow and develop, that there will be much fruit and that he will have all the energy and wisdom needed.

30 Pray for those you see regularly at church, as well as those you might recognise but don't know even by name. Pray also for your own frontline and for gospel and invitation opportunities.
