



## THY KINGDOM COME

**For many years now the churches of Aldershot have gathered together to serve the town through acts of service, worship and prayer.** In keeping with this Aldershot Churches Together (ACT) would like to invite you to join us during the national period of prayer between Ascension Day and Pentecost Sunday (10th to 20th May) called **Thy Kingdom Come**. Spearheaded by the Archbishop of Canterbury and other denominational heads it's a fantastic opportunity for churches to pray together for their town and nation. The climax of the 10 days are 'Beacon' events hosted by Cathedrals and churches around the country.

Together we have put on a series of prayer meetings to gather us together and pray for our town. There is a biblical precedent that we find from God who used the prophet Jeremiah to speak to His people about how they were to pray for the city they lived in: "seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into".

Over these 10 days churches have offered space for Christians of all denominations to gather together to pray for particular areas of life. It is ACT's shared belief that as we pray we will be bearers of hope witnessing the impact of His Kingdom on our town. We are also convinced that our prayers will release many opportunities for people to find a saving faith in Jesus Christ.

Please can we encourage you to join us in prayer over these ten days; from the 10th to the 20th of May; as we declare together across Aldershot: "**Thy Kingdom Come.**"
